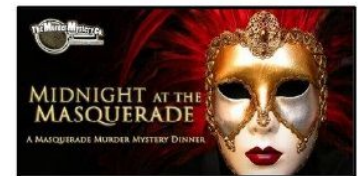
- 5:30 am Depart from Corning-Painted Post High School; Rest breaks made as needed
