**CN Tower:** The thrill begins with a 58—second trip to the top in one of their 6 glass-faced elevators. While visiting the 2 observation levels, you can experience the spellbinding Glass Floor and enjoy a panoramic view of Toronto and beyond from their indoor or outdoor observations. Canada's most celebrated architectural triumph also offers a variety of other activities that will be included during your visit, including:

- **Glass Floor:** With a view 1,122' straight down, even those not afraid of heights might need a little help. Think you can handle it? Wait till you get here and see if you feel the same way. The Glass Floor has been specifically designed for you to have fun on it, so walk or crawl across it, sit on it or even jump on it. Don't worry it won't break. The floor is 256 square feet of solid glass that is five times stronger than the required weight bearing standard for commercial floors. It can actually withstand the weight of 14 large hippos. Also on this level, be sure to check out the Outdoor Observation Level. Feel the breeze at 342m (1,122') above the ground.



**Rogers Centre (formerly known as the Skydome):** The Rogers Centre Tour Experience is the best way to appreciate the wonders of Rogers Centre, one of Toronto's most popular attractions. The tour offers a newly renovated museum area featuring a model of Rogers Centre, memorabilia from past events, concerts and much more! See the multi-screen video wall featuring the many exciting sports and events that have been held at the facility.

Rogers Centre Tour Experience is a one-hour, fully-guided behind-the-scenes tour. Highlights of the tour include a visit to the Blue Jays Hall of Fame, a Press Box, and a luxury Suite among other stops.
